In person presence of members representing five (5) percent of the voting rights of this corporation shall constitute a quorum at this meeting which is required to conduct any official business other than the election of the new board members.

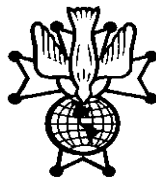
